Position Description:

The successful candidate will ensure that all Laboratories supplies are dispatched to the Laboratory Managers and an excellent tracking system is in place.

Duties and responsibilities:

- Maintain upstream and downstream levels of communication with the laboratory staff, procurement and warehouse teams.
- Distribution of information regarding the availability of laboratory consumables and reagents and other pertinent information to the laboratory staff and WSU-GH, Kenya management.
- Act as a resource person to the laboratory, warehouse and procurement teams regarding the orders and delivery statuses of supplies.
- Maintain adequate stocks of inventory in the laboratory while ensuring there is no wastage of consumables, reagents or product due to shelf storage expiration.
- Perform monthly, quarterly, and annual physical inventory counts for all laboratory supplies located at the laboratories.
- Generate inventory reports for laboratory consumables and reagents.
- Responsible for maintaining proper records of service contracts and repair/service history for all laboratory equipment.
- Responsibilities extend and apply to all locations and sites which the Laboratory may maintain, distribute, and/or utilize inventory in all of its various forms.
- Sharing weekly inventory reports with the Procurement Office and Technical team to ensure WSU GH Kenya management is aware of the stock levels for each project.
- Keep proper records for stocks issued to the lab as well as consumption of reagents and other associated supplies

Qualifications:

- Degree in Supply Chain Management or equivalent qualification from a recognized institution.
- Minimum of 2 years of experience managing inventory.
- Experience in Laboratory inventory management will be an added advantage.
- Proficient in MS Office.

- Attention to detail and meticulous use of proper safety procedures.
- General knowledge of inventory management.
- Ability to work under minimum supervision.
